Instructions

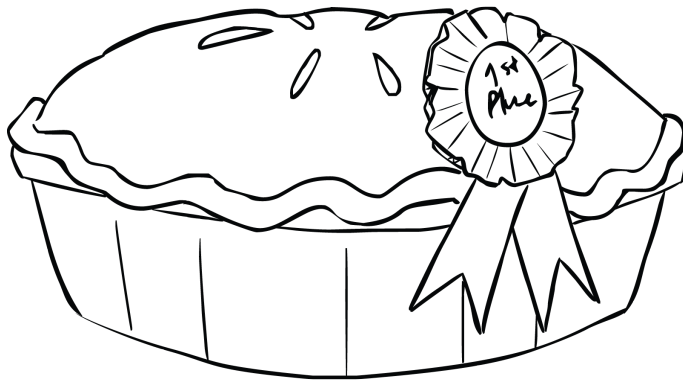
Thirteen ready-to-print clues follow this page, on three pages.

Who	Pie	Prize
Ella	Apple	1
Shira	Peach	2
Antonio	Chocolate	3
Bertha	Pecan	4
Davide	Blueberry	5
Davide	Cherry	6

The solution is sometimes worked best in a grid-like manner, similar to a Sudoku puzzle where you eliminate possibilities with an X as you progress through the clues, as seen below:
