

On Par Scoring Worksheet

Instructions

- 1. One person volunteers to start Game 1 by throwing the dice.
- 2. Observe the rolled number and enter it in the 'Roll' column for Round 1.
- 3. Calculate the difference between the desired number (Par) and this rolled number and record this in the 'Score' column.
- 4. There are no negative numbers, only a whole number representing the difference between these two digits.
- 5. Taking turns, progress to the left around the circle with each person rolling the dice for each consecutive Rounds 2 to 6.
- 6. For Rounds 7 to 12, the next two players will roll the dice (one at a time) and add the sum of their two rolls to the Roll column and then subtract the Par to calculate the Score for that round.
- 7. The next two people roll the dice for Round 8, repeating the process described above.
- 8. When all 12 Rounds have been rolled, tally the numbers recorded in the Score column.
- 9. The team with the lowest total Score wins.
