

Fun Community-Building Program

12 people (20 mins)

1. [All My Neighbours](#) – fun circle game which will reveal more than just laughs
2. [Sticky Beak](#) – rapid elimination-style game that will end your program on a high

Props – roll of masking tape

Step-by-step instructions for each of these activities are provided below.
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1. All My Neighbours (15 mins)

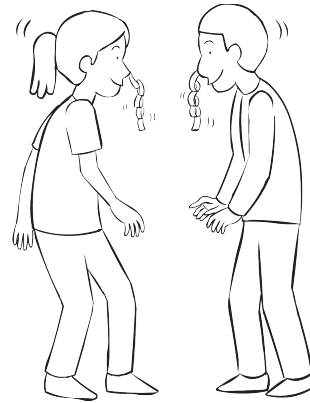
1. Ask your group to form a circle, preferably sitting in seats, facing inwards.
2. Explain that each person's goal is to move around the circle, one seat at a time, and return to the seat they started in.
3. In order to move seats, a person must answer "YES" to a question that is posed by another member of the group.
4. Announce that all moves are one direction only (eg clock-wise).
5. To demonstrate, ask the first question, and invite all those who need to move to shift into the seat to their immediate left-hand side.
6. Explain that if one or more people happen to be in that seat, the person moving is permitted to sit on their lap.
7. Suggest that if three people are already positioned on a seat, the fourth person will simply stand in front of the others.
8. Anyone may ask a question, or you may choose to adopt a particular system to share this role.
9. Continue until someone returns 'home' or your group is exhausted.



2. Sticky Beak (5 mins)

1. Prepare pre-cut 10cm (4") strips of masking-tape, one for each person in your group.
2. Ask each person to grab a strip and roll it into a circle, end-to-end, with the sticky side facing out.

3. Next, ask everyone to place this masking-tape circle onto the end of their nose.
4. Explain that on "GO," each person attempts to 'steal' the masking-tape from another person by gently touching it with their own strip of masking-tape.
5. Game continues until one person remains with the accumulated strips of masking-tape (belonging to everyone else) on the end of their nose.

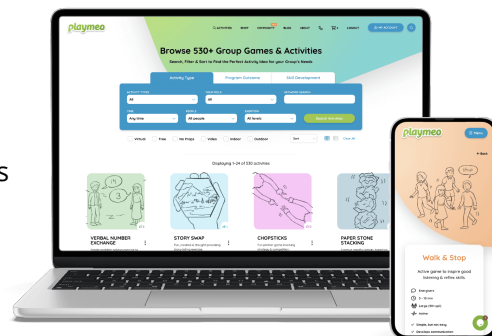


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
